Artists Statement

A greater part of my work outlined below has tried to embrace the notion of collective collaboration and participation. Learning and creating through shared experience with both urban and rural communities. With art as the catalyst a collective response to place or shared experience can be explored. The resulting artworks have included murals, paintings, mosaics, ceramics, digital graphics and printmaking. Recently I moved my studio to Callala Bay, a small village on the Northern Arc of Jervis Bay. This unhurried and beautiful location, the tidal continuum and ever changing shoreline, now offer limitless possibilities for both inspiration and reflection. The rich layering of textures, colours and the moods of the Bay are the flux for abstract hybrids that celebrate this energy in paint, print and mixed media collage.
